Overview

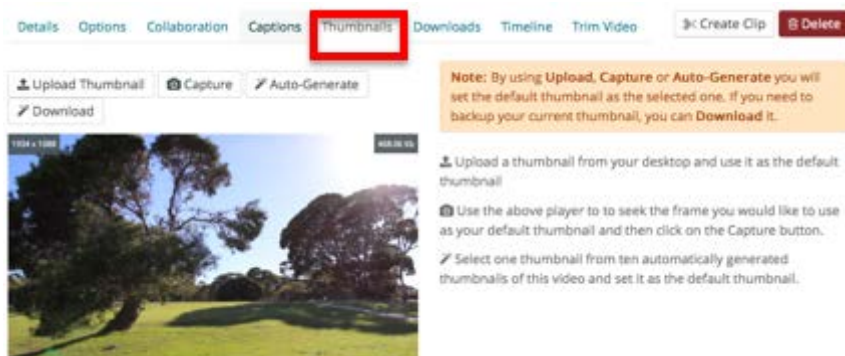
There may be a time when you want to use a thumbnail (small image) to represent your video. You can select, and change images for thumbnails from within the Edit tools in DeakinAir and CloudDeakin.

Using thumbnails in DeakinAir

1. If using DeakinAir go to **'My Media'** under your name heading, and you will see the clips list. If you are accessing your video from within CloudDeakin select **'My Tools'** from the unit site Navbar and click on 'DeakinAir'. Select 'Edit'.
2. Select the 'Edit' function on the clip.

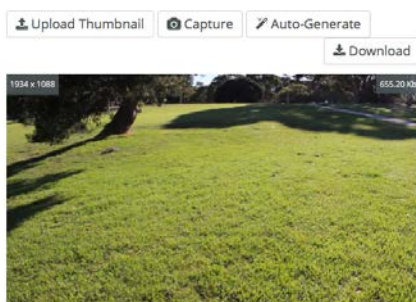


3. Select 'Thumbnails'.

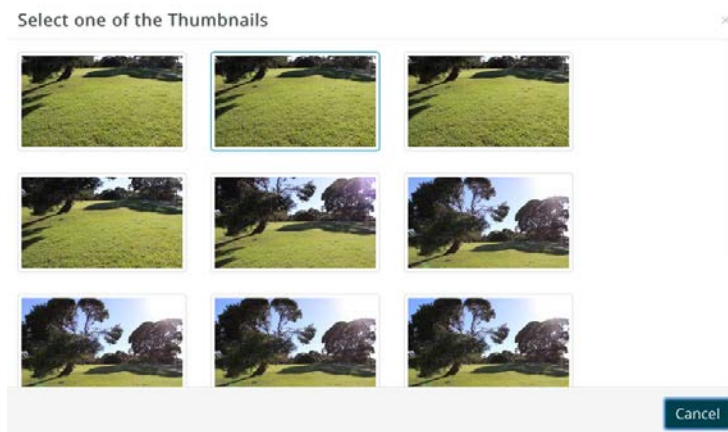


Options

- Upload Thumbnail: select an image on your computer to upload, such as a .jpg
- Capture: This allows you to select a still image of the video. Play the clip, and press 'capture' button when the image appears that you want to use – a sample appears below.



- Auto-Generate: A series of images are selected from the video clip. Select the one you want to use. The new image will update automatically as the new thumbnail.
