



Tips for a successful video presentation recording.

Wardrobe

1. Avoid wearing chroma key green. Wearing green that is similar to the green screen, will cause keying issues.
2. Avoid wearing white
3. Avoid wearing anything with fine stripes, dots or patterns.
1. Wear pastel colours, as the camera 'likes' these hues and will record well.
2. Wear a top that a microphone can be clipped onto.
3. Wear appropriate makeup, but not too heavy.
4. Be prepared for the crew to apply a flat foundation makeup if your skin is shiny.

Writing

1. Write the script for spoken informal conversation, not for formal reading.
2. Aim to be succinct and engaging.
3. Ensure that the script has been read by DLF prior to the recording.

Presenting

1. Know your material.
2. Practice your delivery before recording.
3. If not using a teleprompter, avoid overusing uhm's and ahh's.
4. Be aware of paralinguistics, ie speed, volume and tone.
5. Be confident.
6. Record a test section beforehand to check against the above tips.
